

NEWTON COMMUNICATIONS ACCESS CENTER, Inc.
Membership Fee Rate Sheet - Effective May 1995

In order to become a member of NCAC, a person or organization must:

1. provide proof of Newton residency or corporate address in Newton,
2. complete a Membership Application Form,
3. attend a member orientation session,
4. sign the Agreement with the Rules and Procedures,
5. pay the required membership fee.

(Applicants claiming cable subscriber fee rate must provide NCAC their last month's cable bill.)

Categories of membership

Fees

Individual Members: have the following privileges:

- a. Receive *Newsletter*
- b. Access to workshops (\$15 materials fee) and use of equipment (free)
- c. Eligible to receive technical advice from the NCAC staff for program production
- d. Eligible to vote at NCAC General Membership meetings (one vote per individual member)

Cable Subscribers	\$20
Non-subscribers	\$30

Family Members: up to four persons living in the same household who apply for membership together. Family members have all the privileges of individual membership, except only one vote can be exercised for each family membership.

Cable subscribers	\$40
Non-subscribers	\$50

Non-profit Organization Membership shall be available for any firms, corporations, organizations, institutions, City Departments, public schools or other entities recognized as non-profit, tax-exempt by the IRS. Groups joining NCAC under non-profit membership shall have all the privileges of Individual Membership, except that only one vote may be exercised per Non-profit Membership. Non-Profit organizations are eligible to receive training for up to seven people per membership year with training for additional people available at \$10 per person. In addition, Non-Profit Organization Members may receive specialized group training by contacting the NCAC Executive Director.

Business Membership shall be available for any Newton-based, for-profit firms, corporations, organizations, institutions or other entities. Businesses joining NCAC under Business Membership shall have all the privileges of Individual Membership, except that only one vote may be exercised per Business Membership. Business Members are eligible to receive training for up to four people per membership year with training for additional people available at \$25 per person.
